Some levels even require creative synergy between birds, such as using Bomb to clear a fortified area first and then sending Chuck to finish off the remaining pigs. This system encourages experimentation, rewards precision and skillful play, and ensures that every level becomes a thoughtful puzzle rather than a simple aim-and-shoot task, enhancing both strategy and enjoyment.

### ■ 3. Strategy and Shot Planning

Angry Birds 2 emphasizes strategic thinking and shot planning far more than the original game, turning each level into a carefully considered puzzle. Players must analyze every structure, predict how objects will collapse, and determine the optimal order and angle for launching birds. Blindly firing birds without considering structure integrity or sequence often wastes shots and reduces overall score.
